ONE-STOP SAFETY NET SERVICES

Helping Others Prepare for Eternity (H.O.P.E.) was established in 1997 to turn "despair into Hope" in the lives of abandoned or abused women and children. The organization has grown from its humble beginnings 25 years ago, starting from the trunk of the founder's car into a comprehensive safety net of support services. Today H.O.P.E. provides a vast array of support services with a focus on domestic violence prevention, basic needs, food insecurity and the development of healthy life skills and self-sufficiency.

H.O.P.E.'s THREE CORE PROGRAMS

FAMILY SUPPORT CENTER

The support center specifically addresses the basic physical needs of clients, by providing them with food, emergency rental help, clothing, hygiene products and baby essentials such as diapers.

BRIDGE OF HOPE: HELPING WOMEN SUCCEED
