- Males must be registered for Military Selective Services
- Determine Priority of Services, i.e. Veterans, people with disabilities, basic skills deficient, people on public assistance, and other low income

Dislocated Worker Eligibility:

- 18 Years of Age or Older
- Be a Citizen or Resident authorized to work in the United States
- Males must be registered for Military Selective Services
- Must meet the definition of Dislocated
 Worker
